

## Kewanee Park District – Liberty Park Splash Pad

### Request for Proposals – Splash Pad Equipment

The Kewanee Park District is hereby requesting proposals for the layout, design, engineering, and supply of water feature fixtures for a new splash pad project to be located on the North End of Liberty/West Park located at 611 Park Avenue in Kewanee, Illinois. Proposals are due to the Kewanee Park District Office by close of business on September 24, 2024. Splash Pad requirements are to be consistent with the following parameters:

1. Approximately 1700 – 2000 SF of total area with 900 – 1200 SF of sprayzone area
2. Areas to be separated into Pre-School aged (2-5) & School aged (5-12) area with appropriate features for each section. At least 1 feature of the project is to accommodate wheelchair access.
3. System to be designed as a drain to waste system
4. Maximum flow rate for all spray features will be less than 100 GPM
5. Design to include controls so that the spray features shall be activated by patrons and controlled with a variable sequencing controller
6. Color Scheme of features to consist of main primary colors (blue, red, orange, green, yellow) with no theme desired
7. Features to include at least 3 vertical features per play area and the remaining to be ground features. Including an Overhead low volume dumping water feature

#### Submission Requirements:

1. Plan view of proposed design, or designs that meet parameters listed above
2. 3D color rendering of above design or designs
3. Images of play features with specifications of number of each feature and flow rates for each feature
4. Cost proposal for design, or designs for complete package as listed above, including 80 man hours of on-site coordination for final connections, start-up, & commissioning of selected design.
5. List of (5) recent completed projects of similar size and scope
6. (3) references from recently completed projects

#### Clarifications:

1. Designs are to meet all current applicable federal guidelines and laws for safety and meet or exceed ADA requirements.
2. Workers on the project performing on site installation work shall comply with Prevailing Wage Act of the State of Illinois (820 ILCS 130)
3. Proposals are due via sealed envelope delivered by mail or in-person to the Kewanee Park District Office, 1095 Cambridge Road, Kewanee, IL 61443 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:30 PM., Monday through Friday by the specified deadline. Deadline for submission is September 24, 2024.
4. Bids will be evaluated on a number of criteria, including but not limited to design, references, responsibility, and cost as determined by the Kewanee Park District Board.
